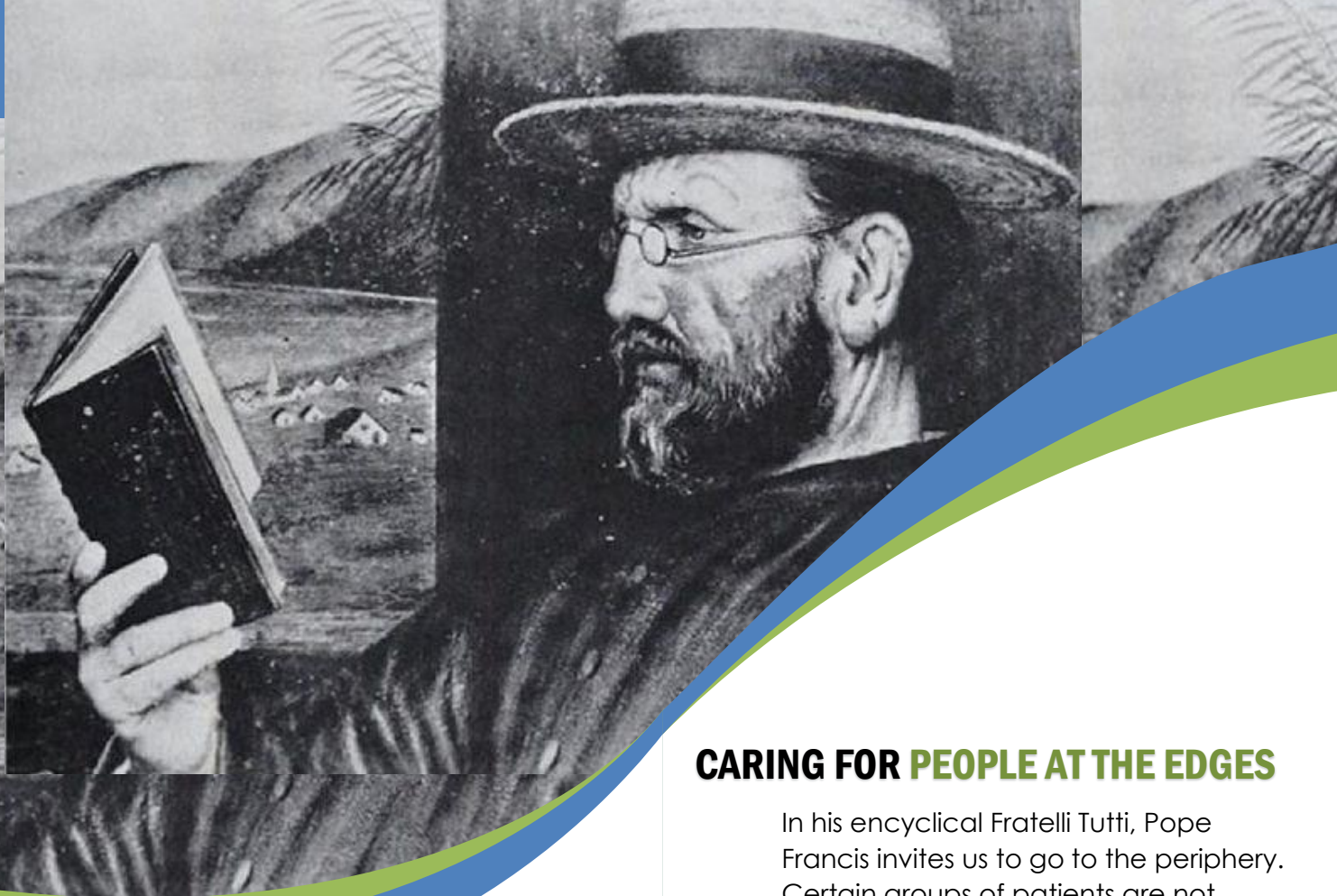

This Belgian priest (photo) lived and worked as missionary among leprosy patients in Molokai Hawaii till his death in 1889. Visitors are welcome in the crypt in Leuven where Father Damien has been buried since 1936.
